Sub: Prompt submission of Investigation reports for complaints received from CVC

Central Vigilance Commission, during review meeting held with Board Vigilance, expressed concern over undue and long delays in submission of Investigation Reports pertaining to cases of IR and FI categories.

- 2. As per Paras 503.1 & 503.4 of IRVM-2018, IR & FI cases have to be submitted to Commission within 12 weeks and 6 weeks respectively from the receipt of reference from CVC. Further as per para 504.4 of IRVM-2018, PIDPI complaints should be given the top most priority and investigation into such complaints should be completed within 3 weeks and sent to Railway Board for enabling onward transmission to Commission.
- If due to unavoidable reasons, it is not possible to complete investigation within specified period, the SDGM/CVO should personally look into the case and seek time indicating progress made, reasons for delay and the date by which final report would be sent to Railway Board so that Board Vigilance may approach Commission for requesting the extension of target date of submission of report.
- 4. Necessary action may be taken immediately and reports pending in this regard shall be furnished within stipulated time.
